Target note comments

- 01 Tall and dense bramble scrub with dying Ash trees
- 02 Dense scrub with variety of species including Pedunculate Oak, Hawthorn, Blackthorn, Dog Rose, Bramble
- 03 Area with many large Goat and Grey Willows
- 04 Blackthorn thicket along north-eastern boundary
- 05 Woodland with lots of Pedunculate Oak, Grey and Goat Willows
- 06 Bramble scrub with some trees
- 07 Blackthorn scrub
- 08 Grassy areas heavily grazed by rabbits
- 09 Pond area open water covered with duckweed and algae, with a stand of Yellow Flag Iris and Pendulous Sedge at western end. Adjacent grassland mostly Creeping Bent alongside a patch of Common Nettle
- 10 Large area of bramble thought to have developed over compacted former agricultural headland
- 11 Ancient Field Maple (400-500 years)
- 12 Woodland dominated by Field Maple
- 13 Ancient Pedunculate Oak (400-500 years)
- 14 Blackthorn thicket
- 15 Heavily shaded pond now holds water after heavy rains of winter 2020-2021 following a dry period of 15 years
- 16 Mature Wild Pear
- 17 Scrub transitioning to woodland
- 18 Expanse of dense scrub with small pathways through this end of the site is favoured by the resident Turtle Dove
