## Membership and the charity

Histon & Impington Green Spaces' <u>Constitution</u> establishes two categories of membership: trustees and ordinary members. The trustee board provides governance and strategic guidance. Day to day operations are managed by supporters through a committee structure (<u>Organisational Structure</u>). Trustees are members who have put themselves forward and been elected to the role at an AGM.

Information about the conduct of the AGM will be circulated to all members via email in advance. All papers for the AGM will be made available to members in sufficient time to allow for proper consideration prior to the meeting.

The charity has a number of <u>Policies</u> which set out the best practice in key areas as we seek to manage risk and engender a fully collaborative and friendly way of working so that all our volunteers can enjoy making their contribution to the charity's progress.

The charity's Vision (<u>Our Vision</u>) sets out a high level road map. The trustee board is responsible for strategic planning, deciding on near and longer term targets for activities that match the charity's objects as registered with the Charities Commission.
